Mouth Guards, Shin Guards

Due to the fact that hockey is considered a high contact sport, it is imperative that all players wear mouth guards and shin guards for all training sessions and matches.

Club Gear

Full club kit must be worn for all club games. Full kit is as follows:

- Red club shirt
- Black Skort
- Black socks (alternative colours are red or white – depending on opposition)
- Runners (preferable astro-turfs)

Replying to Texts

Prior to a match, a text will be sent to all players informing them of the venue, time, and kit details for that particular match. The player/parent needs to reply to these texts as soon as possible. This allows the managers to manage matches and teams more effectively.

Training and Match Attendance

It has been agreed that Galway Hockey Club will maintain a record of player's attendance, at training sessions and matches. A player will not be allowed to play matches unless they have been attending training sessions on a regular basis.

Parent Involvement

Any parent involvement is appreciated. Parents are generally required to help out in the following areas;

1. away trips for matches (a minimum of two parents travelling per team is required)
2. attending training sessions (a rota will be drawn up by the team managers)
